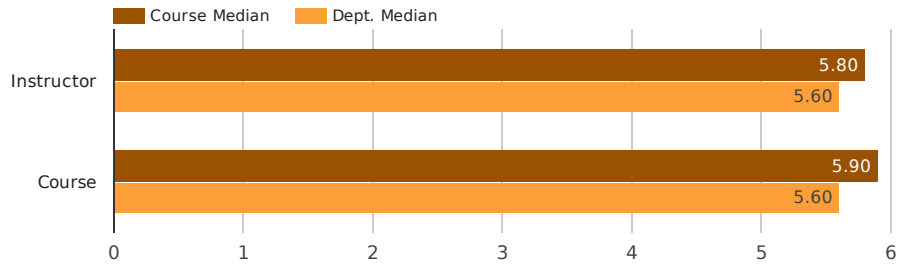

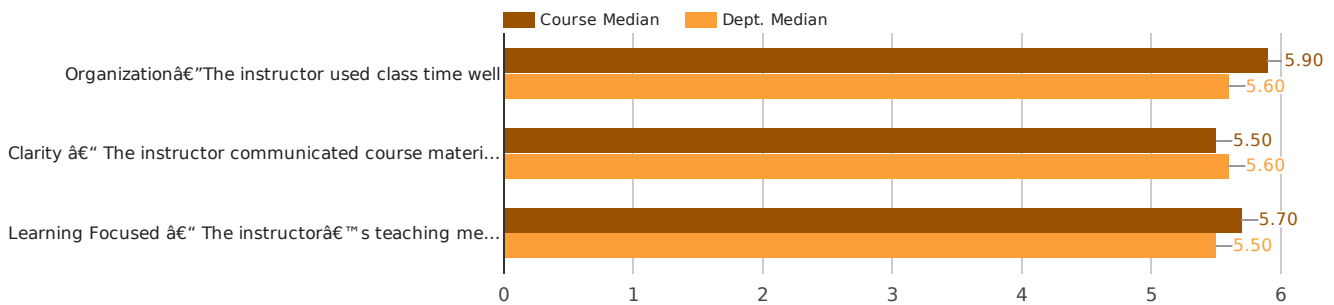

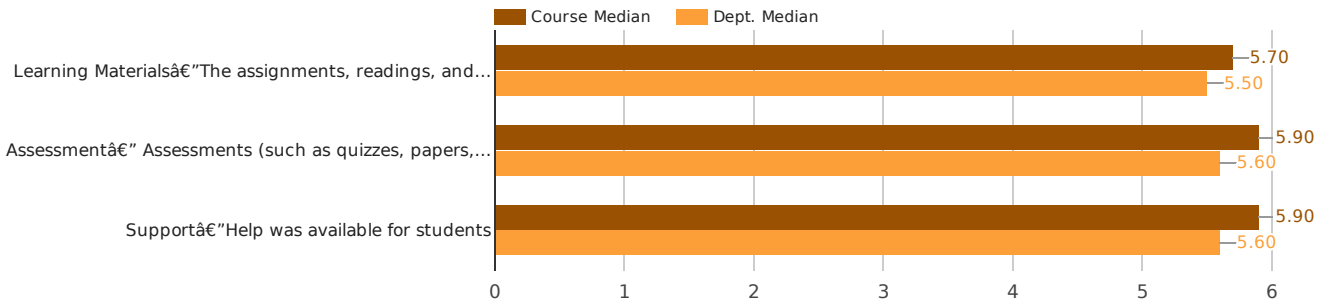

## Q: What aspects of the course were most useful for your learning?

## Q: When this class is taught again, what changes would you suggest?

- 1 In the future, I would suggest uploading everything to ICON at the start of the semester. You could lock access to specific things by the date you want them released. This way students do not have to wonder if something is going to be added or dropped from ICON during the week.
- 2 I would suggest some more involvement of the reading into quiz questions and lessons
- 3 Nothing
- 4 I'd suggest that there'd be more focus on a more narrow set of subjects. It seems like the course covered a lot of subjects, but I'd prefer more comprehensive instruction of fewer topics.
- 5 Being more clear on due dates of assignments and instructions for final exam/paper/presentation
- 6 I liked how low maintenance the class was and how it was more focused on the lecture/readings and actually understanding the material. If you were to add more assignments, I think another reflection paper in the middle for the semester would be nice or have students write a short paper on the topic of their choosing.
- 7 More discussion in class, opportunity for group discussion or group work. Seeing how the material is applied in real world scenarios and what is the current news.
